

VOICES OF SOUTH TEXAS OLD BAYVIEW CEMETERY COMES ALIVE

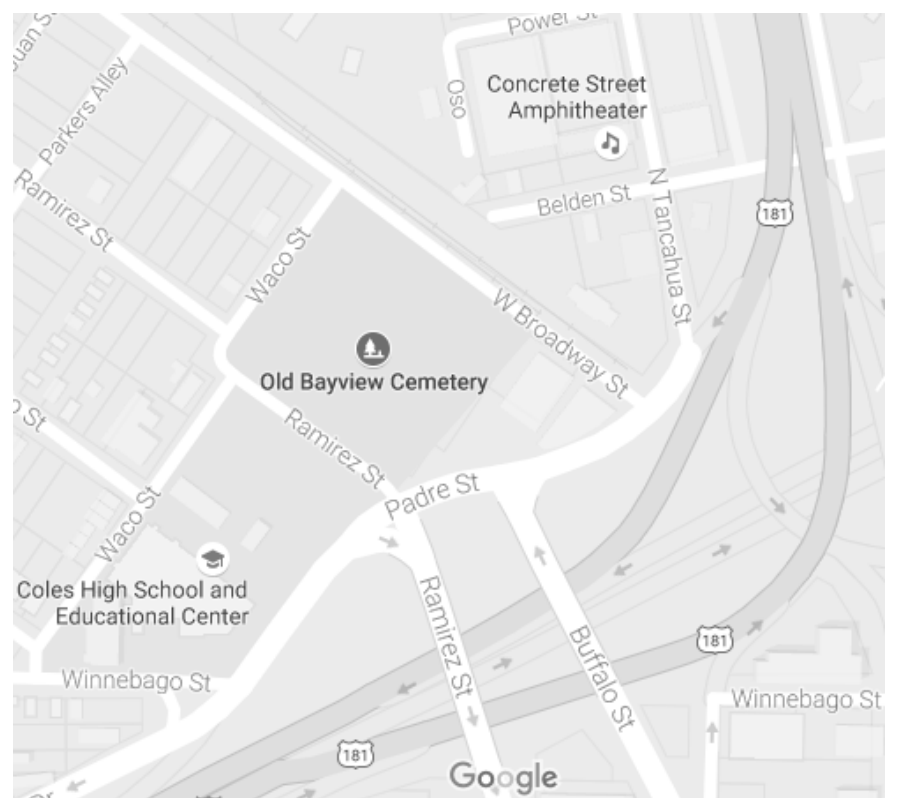

Voices of South Texas - Old Bayview Cemetery Comes Alive is a walking tour which brings voice to the history of our community. The cemetery includes veterans from the War of 1812 through the Spanish American War. It chronicles the history of the region with “voices” brought to life by storytellers, reenactors and experts in the study of local history.



Old Bayview Cemetery was created by Colonel Hitchcock during the occupation of Zachary Taylor's forces in 1845 and is the first U.S. military cemetery in Texas.
